### ABOUT

Dr. Noreen Green is the Founding Artistic Director and Conductor of the Los Angeles Jewish Symphony (LAJS), which she established in 1994. A trailblazing and widely respected conductor, educator, and lecturer, she is known worldwide for her expertise in presenting music with Jewish themes. She has appeared as a guest conductor and speaker across the United States, Israel, South Africa, Spain, Australia, Canada, and the Caribbean, bringing people together through the universal language of music through a Jewish lens.

Dr. Green has been honored by *Musical America* as one of the Top 30 Professionals of the Year and was inducted into the Marquis Who's Who Biographical Registry. Her life and career have also been featured in a documentary by the Milken Archive of Jewish Music. Under her direction, LAJS has performed at major venues including Walt Disney Concert Hall, The Soraya, and Royce Hall at UCLA, and has collaborated with celebrated artists such as Emily Bear, Tovah Feldshuh, Randy Newman, Dave Koz, Hershey Felder, Melissa Manchester, and Inon Zur. Deeply committed to both new works and traditional repertoire, she has commissioned and premiered over 100 compositions and released two LAJS albums on the Albany Records label.
