"Israel is in the middle of the heart of a new battle, and the Jews of Europe are concerned; we consider the fate of the State of Israel — parallel with the fate of the Jews," he said, noting that since the beginning of the intifada, anti-Semitic attacks have increased in Europe, and in his home country, France

With more than 700,000 Jews in France compared to 5 million Arabs, French Jews have an uphill battle to fight in the media, "much worse than America," Cwajgenbaum said.

The head of the EJC, a branch of the World Jewish Congress, was speaking from the Bel Air home of Hanns Donig, who hosted a small dinner party with esteemed guests such as comedian Red Buttons.

Buttons was recently awarded the title of Major in the U.S. Army reserves by Veterans for America. "It was a great honor," Buttons told the dinner guests over pasta and champagne.

Cwajgenbaum then told Buttons his name in French (Rouge Boutons) and in Hebrew (Kaftor Adom). "No one's ever told me that one before," Buttons said, pleased.
