The conductor and selected soloists of the Los Angeles Jewish Symphony will join Israel's Rubin Academy Orchestra in a program of "Cinema Judaica: Film Music with Jewish Themes" on May 14 and 15 at Tel Aviv University.

Dr. Noreen Green, artistic director and conductor of the Los Angeles orchestra, said the program will pay tribute to the soldiers of the 1976 Entebbe rescue mission by playing selections from the film "Victory at Entebbe" by composer Charles Fox. Veterans of the historic raid will attend the performance.

Other concert selections will include "Suite from 'The Ten Commandments'" by Elmer Bernstein, " 'Schindler's List' Suite" by John Williams, " 'Exodus' Cello Rhapsody" by Ernest Gold, "Ruth, A Narrative Poem with Music" by Franz Waxman, and "Palestinian Suite" by Dimitri Tiomkin.
